- Eligibility** : Male and female Scouts **aged 13 to 17** at the start of the Jamboree are eligible to participate in the SG60 Singapore International Jamboree.
- Troop Structure** : Each Troop will consist of **four patrols**, with ***eight Scouts in each patrol***, totaling **32 Scouts** and **4 adult leaders**.
- For each Troop, the National Scout Organization (NSO) may appoint one Contingent Management Team (CMT) member and up to four International Service Team (IST) members.
